Dear Parents / Carers.

Year 6 enjoyed a wonderful week at PGL this week. The weather was kind and they managed to pack a lot into their three days: body boarding, archery, zip-lining, rifle shooting and abseiling to name a few of the activities. Coming back to school yesterday was tough for them after an exhausting few days but the majority made it showing great strength and resilience.

As we move into July on Monday, our Y6s will be making the most of their last month with us, starting with the Diocesan Leavers Mass on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup>. This Mass brings twelve of our family of 35 schools together in collective worship. The coach will leave school at around 10am and arrive back well in time for the end of the day. This always proves to be lots of fun for the children and is one of my favourite activities of the year, waiting to see what new business ideas the children come up with. 




Our Summer Fayre is being held on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

## PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR **SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS CHANGING**

#### **FIRST OFFENCE**

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance the amount will be:



## SECOND OFFENCE (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child to be paid within 28 days. No reduced rate will be offered.

The following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024.



#### THIRD OFFENCE AND ANY FURTHER OFFENCES (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court. Magistrates; fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a Parents future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education'.

#### 10 SESSIONS (5 DAYS) OF UNAUTHOURISED ABSENCE IN A 10-WEEK PERIOD

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthourised absence in a 10-week period.
