CPR & Defibrillator Training

We welcomed back the charity, Jay's Aim today to lead CPR and Defib training for our Y5 and Y6 classes. The British Heart Foundation estimates that 12 people below the age of 35 die every week in the UK from undiagnosed heart conditions, many of them with no prior symptoms. Since 2018 Jay's Aim has been on a mission to reduce this number. The charity fundraises to provide defibrillators for public spaces and educates in the use of saving someone's life by knowing how to use them. The Sacred Heart defibrillator is positioned outside the front office.

Teachers, children and parents will be informed about this by the end of June. This gives plenty of time for transition work to take place for children. Our focus after half term and throughout June will be on end of year assessments followed by annual reports to parents in July.
