

The Wonderful World of Butterflies and Bees

BIG Question

Are smaller creatures less important?

Welcome back year two!

This half term our enquiry project will centre around our Science learning. The children will learn about what a plant needs to stay healthy and how plants look when they don't get the things that they need. They will also learn about the life cycle of a plant and the importance of insects like butterflies & bees to their life cycles.

The children will complete a weekly 'class plant diary' as a result of an experiment to find out 'what plants need to stay healthy'. At the end of the term, they will create an information leaflet to explain how to grow a daffodil.



English

In English, we will be:

- Writing descriptive texts on familiar environments
- Evaluating writing with adult support and using peer feedback
- Rereading to check that writing makes sense
- Proofreading to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation (for example, ends of sentences punctuated correctly)

DT

The children will design, make and decorate a 'Bee B&B'.

- To design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria
- To generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through talking, drawing, templates, mock-ups and, where appropriate, information and communication technology
- Evaluate their ideas and products against design criteria
- Build structures, exploring how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable

Vocabulary

The development of vocabulary is important to us at Sacred Heart. Through this enquiry project we will develop the following vocabulary:

Leaves, trunk, branch, root, seed, bulb, flower, stem, wild, garden, deciduous, evergreen, observe, grow, compare, record, temperature, predict, measure, diagram, germinate, warmth, sunlight.

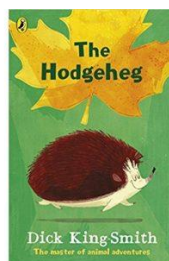
