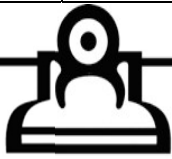

PSHE	Exploring body image, emotional changes and the impact of what we see online

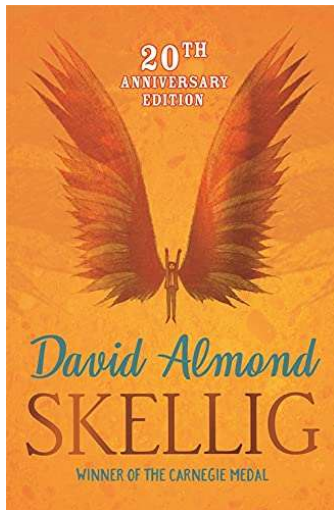
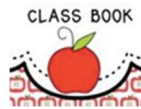


### Reminders
