Dear Parents / Carers,

As we race towards the end of term, we have so much to still fit in. Y6 have had a particular busy week. On Tuesday, Y6, joined by Isaac and Amelia from Y5, participated in a Diocesan Leavers Mass in Exeter. They were joined by seven other Plymouth CAST schools from the South Devon region. The service was led by Canon Mark O'Keefe who some of the children remembered from his time as Parish Priest at Sacred Heart.

Starting Secondary School September 2025

If your child was born between **1st September 2013** and **31st August 2014**, it is nearly time to apply for a secondary school place for September 2025.

The application period is open from **1st September 2024** until **31st October 2024**

Does your child have an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP)?

YES

The SEN Team will manage your application and consult with your preferred **and** local school.

Please apply in the normal way using the Citizen's Portal.

NO

Please make your application using the Citizen's Portal.

You **cannot** apply for a specialist provision if your child does not have an EHCP. Please do not select a specialist provision, as this preference will be **disregarded**.

Do you wish to apply for a grammar school or a selective place at The Spires College?

YES

Your child must sit a selective test. Places are awarded by test result alone. It does not matter where you live.

You must register for the test by **17th July 2024**, check the school's website for registration form.

Selective testing will take place on **Saturday 14th September 2024**.

NO

Complete your application on the Citizen's Portal.

You **cannot** apply for a selective school if your child did not sit the test.

Please do not select a Grammar school, as this preference will be **disregarded**.

Do you wish to apply for either the Football or Performing Arts Academy at Torquay Academy?

Please complete a supplementary form and submit to Torquay Academy by **20th September 2024**

The aptitude test for the Performing Arts Academy and The Football Academy will take place on **Saturday 5th October 2024**

PENALTY NOTICE FINES FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS CHANGING

1

FIRST OFFENCE

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days
Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

SECOND OFFENCE (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child to be paid within 28 days. No reduced rate will be offered.

The following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after **19th August 2024.**

THIRD OFFENCE AND ANY FURTHER OFFENCES (WITHIN 3 YEARS)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court. Magistrates, fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a Parents future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education'.

10 SESSIONS (5 DAYS) OF UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE IN A 10-WEEK PERIOD

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period.
